

**Titusville Environmental Commission  
Regular Meeting  
February 18, 2004**

The Titusville Environmental Commission (TEC) of the City of Titusville, Florida, met in regular session in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 555 South Washington Avenue, on Wednesday, February 18, 2004

Chairman Dean Pettit called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Present were Members Tony Koromilas, Alex Chamberlain, Karen Mills, George Mosakowski and Alternate Member Christine Ryba. Also in attendance were City Grants Coordinator and Projects Manager Richard Stillwagon, Planning Administrator Keith Cunningham and Recording Secretary Randy Woodruff. **New Business:**

Trails Update – Richard Stillwagon distributed to TEC copies of the trail master plan and supplied the group with status and updates on the trails. Compiling documents relating to cost estimates and specifications necessary to prepare bid packages. There are still some problems with cost estimates since they are three years out of date. Mr. Stillwagon told TEC he is looking at ways to lower cost for products needed to construct the trails. Discussion followed. Project must be completed by December 31, 2005 or funding will be lost. Discussion followed.

Sidewalk Ordinance – Member Chamberlain told TEC that he had spoken with Jim Herron from Public Works regarding sidewalks along Riverside Drive that were not replaced. Mr. Herron will provide more details on the sidewalks. Discussion followed.

Member Chamberlain made a motion to recommend that the new trail ways plan be the one used for the City of Titusville. Member Koromilas seconded the motion. Discussion followed.

Draft Environmental Impact Statement for International Space Research Park – TEC began a discussion of the request for review from NASA and the different options.

Asked if staff had requested Council support for the Environmental Awards program. Mr. Cunningham told TEC that staff had not completed the request. Discussion followed.

Staff – Relayed to TEC the items on the Planning and Zoning Commission’s agenda.
